SAC Money Update:

- c. Gym logo -

 - ii. Vinyl cast
- d. Mascot

SSP Data Update

- a. Math Data
 - i. 65% is the HRCE benchmark
 - ii. Right now in the more difficult units more kids are having difficulty.
 - iii. Focus on having the FIT times, students are coming with better questions of where they are stuck rather than saying they don't know how to do. Shows comfort level + relationship building
 - iv. Developed a rubric for conversations and observation assessment opportunities.
 - v. With outcome based assessment this has proven easier and also shows that we are not just looking for products.
 - vi. Next cycle of pull for data from HRCE is mid-June
