- 5. **Class changes for grades 7-9**. We have been getting some requests for class changes. Classes were put together last year by the feeder schools and our teachers and those classes arrangements have been kept. No changes will be made at this time as classes are balanced in numbers, needs, etc.
- 6. **Grade 7 and Powerschool.** Now that you have a child in grade 7, Powerschool will be an important tool for you to be using to get access to your child's grades on assignments, attendance, etc. Please make sure you can access your account.
- 7. **Cell Phone and social media guidelines.** See information package attached to review guidelines.
- 8. **Student Drop-Off/Parking lot.** Please review the information sent home in the information package (pictures have been provided). We have seen cars parked in the student parking area at the end of the day waiting to pick up students. Please park on the outside of the parking lot with sign that says visitor parking. Vehicles will be ticketed which do not adhere to these guidelines.
- 9. **Bussing at the end of the day and safety.** Students need to stay at the front of the school or inside the main foyer/cafeteria to view the white board with the list of busses that are in the loop for the first round. If your child is allowed to access social media, they can also view this @WBHBusDeparture on "X". The following link will take you to the "X" handle <a href="https://x.com/WBHBusDeparture">https://x.com/WBHBusDeparture</a> If they are not going to be on social media, the busses will still be posted on the white board in the main lobby. Having "X" is an added layer of communication, but not necessary.

Please check <a href="https://hrcetransportation.mybusplanner.ca/">https://hrcetransportation.mybusplanner.ca/</a> for information about your child's bussing. If your child has access to your account, they can also see where there bus is at any time.

In regard to safety, students are not allowed to walk through the bus loop, they must stay on the sidewalk when accessing their bus.

Students walking home, or going to parking lot area to be picked up should not be cutting between cars, but stay on the sidewalk going down, or stick to the outside area of the parking lot when walking around. Please speak to your children around this.
