Course Selection 2026-27

- Grade 10 and 11 course selection sheets are due Monday. Students entering grade 11 should have 7 courses listed, and grade 12 students need 6. All students must also include 3 alternate courses. Alternative selections are important. Just because a course is listed, it does not guarantee that it will run next year. School counsellors will be reviewing the selection, but students are responsible for making sure that they have all their required courses for graduation and post-secondary plans. These forms should be signed by a parent/guardian and handed into their Teacher Advisors.
- Grade 9 selections were due last week. School counsellors will be connecting with students who have not submitted forms or submitted incomplete forms.
- Students will begin entering the selections into the Power School portal February 27-March 6.
