Dear WBH Wolves and families,

Please review the information below to help plan for the coming week and what is happening at West Bedford High.

 West Bedford High School Parent Teacher: Our parent-teacher conference will be held on Thursday, April 18th. Report cards go home on Wednesday, April 17th. We will be using an online booking system, called School Interviews, to schedule appointments with teachers. Appointments are scheduled in 7-minute intervals. Staff will be in the gymnasium / cafetorium to accommodate timely transitions between appointments.
